

Muscle

Ever wanted to be the stage manager behind the scenes of a camp? Does the life of a child-friendly roadie intrigue you? Come be the muscle that allows the body of camp to move.

The details:

- Lifting (up to 50 lbs.) and bending are required.
- Fun, adaptable personalities who are capable of multitasking and planning ahead are a must!
- Maintain and set up all camp equipment (A/V, water jugs, tables, chairs, golf carts, etc.)
- Set up activities such as field games and bicycling.
- Assist all of camp with building props, stages, canopies or anything else to help pull off an awesome week!

Spontinators

Do you love being in front of an audience? Can you create spontaneous skits, songs, and games all in the name of laughter and joy? If your middle name is spontaneous FUN, then this is the role for you! When the red phone of “No Fun Being had at Camp” rings, we want you to be a part of the strike team of joy!

The details:

- At least one year of experience as Camp Goodtimes volunteer staff is strongly recommended.
- An ability to work together as a team, bring high energy, and to gauge the needs of campers.
- Lead camp through the week in all things fun! Insert yourself into cabins and inject goofy spontaneity wherever you are.
- Do announcements during meals, put on skits and guide the camp through the week’s theme.
- Kick off songs and camp activities and get campers involved.
- Assisted individual campers or cabins who might need a little extra joy in their day.
- Perpetuate and create new camp traditions.

Activity Crew

Are you interested in facilitating a variety of activities throughout the week of camp? Would you be willing to become an expert in something and help kids learn to love it? Would you be willing to help out in many activities and functions when your activity isn’t being run?

The details:

- Become an expert (or bring your expertise) in one of the camp activities such as fishing, arts and crafts, bicycling, leather-working, lanyards, etc.).
- Prioritize camper safety and well-being while engaging and leading each activity.

- Throughout the week, be attentive to what works with kids and what doesn't, and adapt accordingly.
- Follow up with campers who show an interest in a specific activity.
- Help kids who are having trouble understanding/engaging the activity and show/teach them how much fun new experiences can be!

CAP (Cabin Assistance Personnel)

Like the idea of being a cabin counselor but wish you could see more of camp? Want to work with lots of different kids and age groups? CAPs work with a specific number of cabins all week to be co-counselors in the cabins and provide a fresh face and energy each day.

The details:

- Assist and influence a specific number of cabins for the entire week.
- Fill in for cabin counselors during their daily time off.
- Provide a physically, socially and emotionally safe, inclusive environment for campers.
- Be able to adapt to meet the needs of campers with a variety of physical and developmental needs.
- Be a consistent and fun breath of fresh air in your assigned cabins.

ULs (Unit Leaders)

Do you have great people management skills or a knack for handling child behavioral issues? ULs work as a team to ensure the camper management portion of camp runs smoothly.

The details:

- At least one year of experience as Camp Goodtimes volunteer staff is required.
- Oversee a group of cabins and help encourage, grow and guide the cabin counselors..
- Ability to provide consistent and constructive feedback.
- Be familiar with camp procedures and protocols.
- Work closely with Camp Director and administrative staff.
- Help resolve sometimes rough cabin dynamics when you see an issue with either the counselors or campers.
- Assist in implementation of cabin or group special activities during the week.

Counselor

Are you good at working with young kids, tweens or teens? Enjoy leading by example in both fun and safety? Do you like interacting with kids in small groups of 8 to 10? Can you collaborate with another counselor and CAP to not just provide a fun and safe week for your campers, but to also help them grow?

The details:

- Lead by example in safety and in appropriate fun.
- Provide a physically, socially and emotionally safe, inclusive environment for campers.
- Be able to adapt to meet the needs of campers with a variety of physical and developmental needs.
- Sleep in a cabin with a co-counselor and 8-10 kids for the entire week.

Activity Director

Are you a natural-born event planner or one by trade? Does executing a schedule and managing teams of people from behind the scenes to pull off the most awesome week of camp sound like fun? Then, come help us run the best week of camp and work with some of the best camp staff in the world.

The details:

- At least one year of experience as Camp Goodtimes volunteer staff is required.
- Oversee and empower the program and activity staff.
- Implement camp plan – make sure the week runs on schedule and on time.
- Balance the assigned duties of your team with the last-minute needs of the campers and other staff to deliver a safe and fun week for everyone.
- Troubleshoot activities and programs.
- Steer creative events throughout the week.
- Program must meet a wide variety of camper ages, needs and abilities

Office Assistant

Do you have office skills that you want to bring to camp? If you are a more behind-the-scenes person that loves policy and office management, then this is the role for you! Come help and ensure that the paperwork side of camp runs smoothly and help us deliver an amazing week for the campers!

The details:

- At least one year of experience as Camp Goodtimes volunteer staff is required.
- Manage all camper and staff paperwork, ensuring all are in compliance with relevant policies.
- Help drive camper and staff check-in and check-out.
- Deliver camper and staff mail throughout the week and assist campers with letters home.
- Possess a general knowledge of camp so you can assist with any questions that come through the camp office during the week.

Arts and Crafts

Are you that person who loves to draw, paint or play with colors? Do you have the patience and creativity to work with kids both young and old on camp art projects? If so, then we are looking for you!

The details:

- Design and implement art projects throughout the week
- Work with cabins and individual campers to keep them engaged and encouraged to finish projects.
- Support camp-wide decorating or impromptu events during the week.
- Possess a willingness to work with kids who have high emotional and physical needs.
- Possess an ability to maintain a clean work space in the midst of creative and messy projects.
- Ability to clean up and pack inventory at the end of the camp week.
- Lifting is occasionally required (up to 25 lbs).

Nurse

Are you a pediatric oncology nurse? Would you like to interact with kids outside of the hospital or clinic? If that sounds like you, join our team of nurses and doctors in the “MedShed”.

- Must provide requisite credentials as a professional nurse or nurse practitioner.
- Administer medication to campers.
- Monitor physical and mental well-being of campers and sometimes staff.
- Be present and available at activities around camp and off-site activities.
- Be on call during the day and sometimes at night to respond to medical concerns.
